## Voting for the election of the Core Team of the Intercontinental Christian Fraternity of Persons with Disabilities

## Result of the vote

The Voting Commission, formed by Francisco Nuncio (for the American continent), Jean de Dieu Mopembe (for the African continent) and Marisol García (for the European continent)

## **COMMUNICATE:**

- That this Commission has been chosen to coordinate and follow up voting to elect the Core Team (Intercontinental Coordinator, Adjoint Intercontinental Coordinator and Intercontinental Assessor) of the Intercontinental Christian Fraternity of Persons with Disabilities, to carry out the counting of the votes and to communicate to the acting Core Team the result of the same.
- That on August 17, 2019, in accordance with the agreed date and communicated to all the Fraternities of Africa, America, Asia and Europe, the vote is taken. Subsequently, given the low participation, the term is extended until August 25.
- That the vote is carried out by internet, to an email enabled for such purpose (<u>fraterelec cion2019@gmail.com</u>), for the economic impossibility to hold a Intercontinental Committee in person, and complying with the agreement adopted at the Intercontinental Committee held in Segovia–Spain, from August 16 to 23, 2018.
- That the candidacy presented is composed by: Sonia Leticia Martínez García (Guatemala), as Intercontinental Coordinator; Ma del Carmen Mazariegos (Guatemala), as Adjoint Intercontinental Coordinator; and Miguel Ángel Arrasate Fortuny (Panama), as Intercontinental Assessor.
- That having counted the votes, the result is as follows:

<u>Number of countries</u> (9 of the African continent, 12 of the American continent, 10 of the European continent and 1 of the Asian continent) <u>and people</u> (Core Team in functions and Continental teams of Africa, America, Asia and Europe) <u>with the right to vote</u>: 52.

Number of participants in the vote: 43.

Votes in favor of the candidacy indicated above: 42.

Votes against the candidacy: 0.

Abstentions: 1.

Since points 3.2.3 and 3.2.4. of the Intercontinental Statutes establish that 2/3 of the participation (equivalent to 35 votes) must be reached and there have been 43 votes that have supported the candidacy presented, this does YES reach the established percentage and GET the number of votes in favor to establish the new Intercontinental Core Team of the Fraternity.
